

Livingston County's Fowlerville Fair Queen 2007 – 2008

Fowlerville Fair Queen Contest

Contestants must live in or work in Livingston County.

Contestants must be between the ages of 17 – 24 at the time of the contest.

Contestants must be born female, single, never married, nor given birth to a child.

Contestants and/or family members or guest showing unsportsmanlike behavior will lead to the disqualification of the contestant.

The Fowlerville Fair Board shall determine all decisions as to the eligibility of each contestant.

All decisions of the judged are final and irrevocable.

If for any reason the winner is disqualified, or elects not to participate, her title and all awards including crown and sash will be returned to the Fowlerville Fair Queen Committee and given to the next choice of the judges.

Immediate family members of the Fowlerville Fair Board are not eligible to participate in the competition.

Contestants and their parents/guardians agree to hold harmless all persons affiliated with the Fowlerville Fair Board/Agricultural Society in the case of any loss or injury occurring during or in travel to and/or from any related activities.

Guidelines for the Contest:

Must arrive one (1) hour prior to contest.

Formal attire is recommended for the contest.

Judging will include qualities of poise, personality, public speaking and over all appearance.

If you are crowned the next Fowlerville Fair Queen:

On behalf of the Fowlerville Fair Board and the Queen Committee we would like to congratulate you on becoming the 2007 – 2008 Fowlerville Fair Queen.

As this year's Fair Queen you will receive a \$500 shopping spree. On Monday, July 16, a queen committee member will accompany you to the Kensington Valley Outlet Mall to begin your shopping spree. You also received a crown and sash, to be worn throughout your reign and are yours to keep. As the Fair Queen you will receive a complimentary membership to the Fowlerville Agricultural Society. During the week of the fair you will receive free admission to the fair and all grandstand events, if family members or friends will to attend the fair or any grandstand events they will need to purchase tickets.

Your week as reigning Fair Queen will be filled with a lot of excitement as well as responsibilities. Your main role is to promote and represent the Fowlerville Fair. During the Fair you will be asked to walk around to greet the fair guests and hand out awards at the livestock shows, attend Ladies day, Kids day, and many other events. Each evening of the fair you will be asked to introduce the Grandstand events. If for any reason you are unable to take part in these events the First Runner-up may be asked to fulfill these duties.

You are not limited to this list alone. Please feel free to add any events of your choosing. All we ask in that you clear these with the Queen Committee and possibly the Fair Board. The queen committee has access to a vehicle for most parades. However, if you do have your own form of transportation for the parade (convertible, float, horse, etc...) please advise the Queen Committee.

Additional responsibilities throughout the year will include:

Attending the 2008 – 2009 Fowlerville Fair Queen Contest to crown the new queen.

Provide an 8x10 photo to be displayed in the Fair Office.

Provide a write up and photo for next year's fair book describing your year as the Fowlerville Fair Queen.
